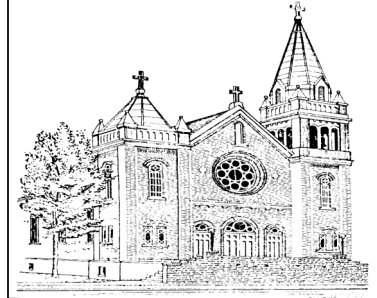

Registration is now open for this year at Camp Guggenheim. Camp Guggenheim is located on Lower Saranac Lake in the magnificent Adirondack Mountains of New York State.
