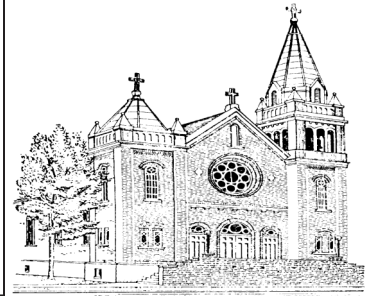

## *St. John Eudes*

St. John Eudes was born in France, November 14, 1601. He was an exemplary child and was extolled as one of the most brilliant students ever to attend the Jesuit College at Caen. As a priest, he was full of zeal for the salvation of souls. He worked valiantly among his countrymen and became known as one of the greatest missionaries of his day. Traveling throughout France, he taught the great truths of the Faith and succeeded in making a host of conversions.

He founded the Congregation of the "Priests of Jesus and Mary" and the Congregation of "Sisters of Our Lady of Charity." The main purpose of the former was the direction of seminaries and the religious instruction of the people through missions. Pope Leo XIII recognized St. John Eudes as the author of the liturgical devotion to the Sacred Hearts of Jesus and Mary. He died on August 19, 1680.

The Diocesan Family Life Office is offering the Surviving Divorce Program this Fall in Canton and Gouverneur.
